NO, these items **can't** go in your FOGO bin

- Baking paper
- Biodegradable plastic bags
- Cardboard*
- Cartons – milk or juice*
- Ceramics
- Certified compostable packaging, cutlery, containers, cups, straws, stirrers
- Clothes or textiles
- Compostable liners that aren't AS4736-2006
- Dust
- Food in containers (only food in FOGO no containers)
- Glass bottles and jars*
- Green / eco / hessian / canvas / reusable bags
- Hair – human or pet
- Household waste
- Logs – greater than 10cm in diameter
- Magazines*
- Metal cans or tins*
- Nappies
- Paper
- Paper towels
- Paper bags
- Pet waste and kitty
- Litter
- Pizza boxes*
- Plant pots
- Plastic bags
- Rocks / gravel / pebbles
- Soil
- Vacuum waste
- Wipes (including compostable ones)

Tip

*Recycle these items in your yellow lid bin



Important points

- Remember food packaging and fruit and vegetable stickers need to be removed from food and cannot go in your FOGO bin
- The NSW EPA released a statement that cardboard, paper towel, tissues, compostable packaging are no longer accepted in the FOGO bin
